Russell Brown, 320 N. Meridian St, Suite 1100, Indianapolis, IN., Mr. Brown stated this is a request to build a 165 foot monopole tower with one 160 feet in height with a 5 foot lightening rod. He stated that Verizon Wireless is a confirmed tenant at this location and will take the 140 foot center line and that leaves three additional co-locators. Mr. Brown stated that there is landscaping on all four sides as stated in conditions. He stated it will be surrounded by a (7) seven foot tall fence with (1) one foot of barbed wire on top of fence. Mr. Brown stated this tower will add to cell coverage between Pittsboro and the Lizton area. He stated this tower will off load some from a tower that is to the south of proposed location.
