Beechwood Construction

Mr. Gentry mentioned that Jim Williams of Beechwood Construction had contacted him to ask if he could move forward with the work on the Batz and John Green Regulated Drains instead of waiting until crops were out. Mr. Maloney commented that it would be a travesty to tear crops out when it is close to the end of the season and crops would be coming out soon. Mr. Hession stated that the quotes were approved based on waiting until crops are out and that it would change the scope of work, making it unfair for other contractors who bid on the projects. It was the consensus of the Board to deny the request.

Stutler Project

Mr. Maloney said he spoke to Dan Smith about the Stutler project and said he was approached to look at the set of plans to see if he could locate a benchmark on the plans. Mr. Maloney could not locate the benchmark. Mr. Gaston stated that they would need to work with Kruse Consulting who designed the project. Mr. Maloney said they were asking about the cost of the project and the County potentially paying for part of it. The Board stated that it is not going to cover any costs for that project. Dave said he would be happy to talk to Dale Kruse about this project.
