

Mechanics Lien Requirements

Indiana Code Reference (IC 32-28-3, IC 36-2-11-16.5)

- 1. Claimant Name with complete Claimant address.
- 2. Recipient/Property owner name with complete address of Recipient/Property owner.
- 3. Complete legal description as listed on deed of property as well as commonly known address.
- 4. All signatures must be notarized. If notarized in Indiana, the following is required.
 - a. Affirmation statement followed by printed name of individual. (I affirm, under the penalties for perjury, that I have taken reasonable care to redact each Social Security number in this document, unless required by law. Printed name of individual NOT Company)
 - b. Must have preparation statement. Must be individual and not business name. (This document was prepared by: Mark Smith)
- 5. Amount of claim.
- 6. Names must be legibly printed or typed under all signatures.
- 7. 2" margin at the top of the document's first page for recording process.
- 8. Entire document must be completely legible. Font size cannot be smaller than 10 pt.. Larger than 10 pt. is strongly encouraged. (IC 36-2-11-16.5)
- 9. If document is mailed in for recording, a self-addressed stamped envelope is required to return original to claimant.
