RE: HENDRICKS COUNTY SURVEYOR DAVID GASTON:

Northern Acres Regulated Drain

Hendricks County Surveyor David Gaston stated his office had received two sealed quotes for the Northern Acres Regulated Drain project. President Palmer asked for the quotes to be opened. The quotes were as follows:

Beechwood Construction \$18,500.00 Murrain Excavating \$39,900.00

After reviewing the quotes Mr. Gaston recommended Beechwood Construction as the lowest responsible quote at \$18,500.00. Member Bob Gentry moved to follow the Surveyor's recommendation. Member Jack Maloney seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously passed.

Statement of Financial Responsibility

Mr. Gaston stated Venture Church had requested their application fees be returned and he had informed them, they would have to come before the Board to request that refund. He asked the Board if they would like to add a line to the Statement of Financial Responsibility document saying that all fees are non-refundable. Discussion followed. President Palmer stated that the Venture Church must come before the Board with their request. The Board also requested Mr. Gaston to put the statement into the document and bring it back for their review.

Kensington Project

Mr. Gaston informed the Board that the Kensington project was being presented to the Town of Danville in an area where the Board and the Commissioners have already received several complaints about drainage. He asked the Board if they would like to review the project before it was approved by the Town of Danville. Discussion followed. The Board asked Mr. Gaston to check the plans to see if the project is proposing to direct any of the water runoff into the un-incorporated portion of the county. If so, then the Board will require application to the Drainage Board.

Milton & Estelle Graham

Mr. Gaston informed the Board that his office and the Commissioners had received a letter from Milton & Estelle Graham concerning erosion on their property in Hidden Valley Estates. Mr. Gaston stated that while it is not a Drainage Board concern, he wanted to make them aware of it and have the letter placed in the minutes. He informed the Board that the Engineering Department, under the direction of the Commissioners, had done some work to shore up the banks in the past and apparently the home owners had some concerns about it washing away. Hendricks County Engineer John Ayers said he planned on going out to inspect the area soon but wasn't sure what more could be done at this time. The Board thanked both gentlemen for bringing the situation to their attention.
