

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-24

Comes now the Hendricks County Board of Commissioners and the Hendricks County Council, and having considered the excess currently existing with public safety funds, does now find:

1. Hendricks County has a surplus of county public safety L.O.I.T. funds currently in its budget.
2. There is a need at the township level for funds for public safety equipment, programs and salaries and benefits.
3. A one time grant from Hendricks County to the various township fire departments and territories will not place the county in a deficit funding position.
4. The proper account for the receipt of the funds shall be the Township Fire and E.M.S. fund.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the County of Hendricks does hereby resolve the following:


1. The County shall transfer funds to the various Township Trustees for Fire and E.M.S. from its public safety L.O.I.T. fund.
2. The grants to the various Township Trustees shall be as follows:


