AUTHORIZING RESOLUTION

Resolution No. 2024-6\

Resolution authorizing the filing of an application for a grant under Section 5339 of the Federal Transit Act, as amended. A resolution of Hendricks County Commissioners is recommending approval of an application to the Indianapolis Public Transportation Corporation for [EQUIPMENT/VEHICLES] assistance (federal Section 5339) to provide public transportation services in Hendricks and Morgan Counties.

WHEREAS **HENDRICKS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS** is submitting an application to Indianapolis Public Transportation Corporation for assistance for Section 5339 Call for Projects 2023.

WHERAS the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) grants limited transportation funds for capital improvements (e.g. vehicles) through its Section 5339 Buses and Bus Facilities Grants Program.

WHERAS Indianapolis Public Transportation Corporation is the designated recipient of the Section 5339 funds in the Indianapolis Urban Area and is responsible for administering the grant and distributing funds.

WHERAS eligible recipients of these funds include Authorized units of local governments, Private nonprofit operators for purposes of carrying out eligible job access and reverse commute projects, Existing Indianapolis Public Transportation Corporation subrecipients providing public transportation services.

WHERAS to be considered for the grant, projects must support public transportation services in the Indianapolis urban area.

WHERAS the 2023 Section 5339 Call for Projects will run from Dec. 15 to Feb. 9, 2024.

WHERAS eligible projects include capital projects such as vehicles, radio and communications equipment, wheelchair lifts and rehabilitation and support systems, such as computer hardware and software.

WHERAS the estimated amount available for this Call for Projects is \$1.2 million.

WHEREAS the contract for financial assistance requires that the **HENDRICKS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS** obligate local funding equal to twenty percent (20%) of the funds requested (for vehicles, equipment) to Indianapolis Public Transportation Corporation upon execution of the funding contract. **SYCAMORE REHABILITATION SERVICES/HENDRICKS COUNTY ARC, INC. DBA LINK Hendricks County** will be assisting with securing/covering the twenty percent (20%) match in accordance with allowable local match options.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY **HENDRICKS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS**:

1. That NANCY MARSH on behalf of HENDRICKS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS is authorized to make the necessary certifications and assurances and be empowered to enter into an agreement with Indianapolis Public Transportation Corporation for the provision of public transportation

services within Hendricks and Morgan Counties to receive public transit under this grant contract.

- That SYCAMORE REHABILITATION SERVICES/HENDRICKS COUNTY ARC, INC. DBA LINK
 Hendricks County is authorized to execute and file an application on behalf of HENDRICKS
 COUNTY COMMISSIONERS with IndyGo to aid in the financing of transit assistance projects pursuant to Section 5339 of the Federal Transit Act, as amended.
- 3. That SYCAMORE REHABILITATION SERVICES/HENDRICKS COUNTY ARC, INC. DBA LINK Hendricks County is authorized to furnish such additional information as IndyGo may require in connection with the application.
- 4. That SYCAMORE REHABILITATION SERVICES/HENDRICKS COUNTY ARC, INC. DBA LINK Hendricks County is authorized to execute grant contract agreements on behalf of HENDRICKS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.
