

**RESOLUTION NO. 2024- 14**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HENDRICKS COUNTY,  
INDIANA APPROVING THE INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN MOORESVILLE, INDIANA AND HENDRICKS COUNTY, INDIANA**

WHEREAS, Indiana Code § 36-1-7 permits interlocal agreements by and between governmental entities; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Mooresville, Indiana (“Mooresville”) and Hendricks County, Indiana (“Hendricks County”) desire to enter into an interlocal agreement related to improvements at the intersection of Hendricks County Road and Old State Road 267; and

WHEREAS, the Hendricks County Board of Commissioners believe it is in the County’s best interest to approve the proposed Interlocal Cooperation Agreement between Hendricks County and Mooresville for said Project.






