## **DETERMINATION OF A QUORUM AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

## 4th QUARTER 2023 REIMBURSEMENT & PROGRAM-TO-DATE AMOUNT

Jeremy Gooch provided the Board with an update on the current total of reimbursement from the state. The program is currently at a cumulative total of \$3,926,036.03. In the fourth quarter of 2023, the reimbursement request was \$173,757.03.

## PROGRAM UPDATE

Mr. Gooch updated the board with new legislation about the new pilot misdemeanor reimbursement. Mr. Gooch has been in communication with Derick Mason to make sure that our county is in in the bill to be reimbursement. If we are approved, it will be in the best effort for the PD board to look at Town Court Cases along with contracts with current public defenders. Gooch has spoken with current attorneys to up their standards with the commission to make sure if contracts are changed then everyone will be in compliance.

#### LWOP UPDATE

Gooch gave an update of the representation of defendant Jones. Currently the program has spent a total of almost \$25,000.
