COURTESY TRANSFER REQUIREMENTS

Hendricks County Community Corrections reserves the right to accept or deny courtesy transfers based on pre-screen criteria including but not limited to:

- Bedspace availability for all genders of participants;
- Employed/Employability;
- Valid Driver's License with vehicle/scooter/community transporters;
- Financial support for meals and living expenses;
- Length of sentence;
- Ability to provide daily self-care; and,
- Mental Health and Health care needs.

Anyone whose current situation involves one or more of the following is automatically a denial for the work release program:

- Current or previous conviction or charge with a sex offense requiring registry;
- Current or previous conviction or charge with a violent offense requiring registry;
- Open warrants from other criminal justice jurisdictions when extradition instructions;
- Holds from other criminal justice jurisdictions;
- Flight Risk (current or previous conviction or charge for escape/failure to return to lawful detention;
- Inability to work (not eligible for disability benefits); and,
- Inability to provide daily self-care.
