Request for Additional time to pay Reconstruction Costs

Hendricks County Surveyor David Gaston stated that Kimberly Van Buskirk and John Schindler had respectively requested additional time to pay back their reconstruction loans for Starkey Subdivision and Northern Acres. Mr. Gaston then introduced Hendricks County Treasurer Nancy Marsh. Mrs. Marsh stated that although the construction was certified and the fees were established in 1994, they did not go on record for the tax roll until 2004. She didn't know why a correction had not been made, as she was not in office at the time. She stated that the owners had been notified of the costs nearing \$8,000.00 with interest and penalties,

and unfortunately there was nothing within the Indiana Code to help in this situation. Discussion followed. Member Matthew Whetstone moved to table this discussion until Mrs. Marsh and Mr. Gaston could meet and discuss the issue with Hendricks County Attorney Greg Steuerwald. Vice President Phyllis Palmer seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.

Robards Regulated Drain - Stilesville request

Mr. Gaston stated that his office had conducted a thorough investigation of the Robards Drain, requested by the Town of Stilesville, and found that the natural surface waterway is not obstructed. Therefore, he recommended no additional work should be done by the Drainage Board. Discussion followed. Member Stan Ryland moved to accept the Surveyors recommendation regarding the Robards Regulated Drain. Member Jack Maloney seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.

Mr. Gaston then recommended that the Board give Mr. Steuerwald directions on what they were comfortable agreeing to. Discussion followed. The Board agreed to take Mr. Gaston's recommendation under advisement and make a decision closer to the hearing date.
