RE: HENDRICKS COUNTY SURVEYOR DAVID GASTON:

Mary A. Gibbs Regulated Drain Project

Hendricks County Surveyor David Gaston informed the Board that CSX Railroad had notified the Surveyor's Office of their requirements before they would approve any work to be done to the Mary A. Gibbs regulated drain that crosses within their easement. They need detailed information on the Vectren and Marathon pipelines which includes the depths and locations. Inspector Blake Stephenson stated he had contacted the pipeline companies and they are requiring the lines be exposed by hydro excavating so they can give an accurate depth and location. Blake informed the Board that due to weather and ground conditions a vac truck is too heavy to drive out there at this time to complete the work and as soon as weather permits it will be done. Mr. Gaston stated he had contacted Christopher Burke Engineering to perform the engineering work and they had submitted a job estimated not to exceed \$32,000.00. Discussion followed. Vice President Palmer moved to accept the estimate and proceed with the design work. President Gentry seconded the motion. The motion was passed on a 3-0-1 vote with Member Jack Maloney recusing himself.

Fluvial Erosion Waiver – Richard Czap (32-07-33-400-024.000-022)

Mr. Gaston informed the Board that he had checked with the Health Department and Planning and Building regarding the Fluvial Erosion Waiver requested by Mr. Richard Czap on behalf of his client. He stated neither department was willing to state unequivocally that Mr. Czap's client would be able to build on the parcel without further study and filing of an MRP. Mr. Gaston stated all the information that would be needed would be done through the planning stage of an MRP and would have to go through each department for review and approval. David Eichelberger stated that if the owner wanted to, he could hire a Geoscientist to map the parcel and determine exactly where the flood plain and fluvial erosion zones were located on the parcel. Discussion followed. Member Dennis Dawes moved to table the waiver until Mr. Czap's client was able to get detailed plan drawings for the building location. Member Jack Maloney seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.

Gailcrest Regulated Drain

Hendricks County Inspector Dirk Leonard stated that someone had restricted the outlet for the Gailcrest Subdivision by installing a pipe where the open ditch used to be located and that the pipe was much too small to

handle the amount of water coming through it. He informed the Board that this pipe is an offsite easement of Gailcrest and is now inadequate making properties flood within the Gailcrest subdivision. He also stated that additional water from Beasley's Orchard had been added to the drain by recent pattern tiling of the orchard property which is within the Town of Danville and that Beasley's Orchard had received approval from the Town to do the tiling work. Discussion followed. Chief Deputy Dalton stated that the tile needed to be removed and the open ditch restored, and to stay consistent with other projects completed in the past, the money to pay for this project would come from Gailcrest drain maintenance fund. Discussion followed. Vice President Palmer moved to let the project for quotes. Member Jack Maloney seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.

Christopher Burke Engineering

The Board was informed that Christopher Burke Engineering had submitted their 2021 contract with no changes from the previous year. Hendricks County Attorney Representative Graham Youngs stated he had reviewed the contract and it was in good order. Discussion followed. Member Dennis Dawes moved to accept the contract. Vice President Palmer seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.

Banning Engineering

The Board was informed that Banning Engineering had submitted their 2021 contract with no changes from the previous year. Hendricks County Attorney Representative Graham Youngs stated he had reviewed the contract and it was in good order. Discussion followed. Member Dennis Dawes moved to accept the contract. Member Jack Maloney seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.
