Mary A. Gibbs Regulated Drain

Hendricks County Surveyor David Gaston informed the Board that the Mary A. Gibbs Regulated Drain project was progressing. Inspector Blake Stephenson stated that Christopher Burke's survey contractor had been out and surveyed the project area.

Old Clermont Golf Course - Rezone

Mr. Gaston stated that the engineering firm for the old Clermont Golf Course site that is seeking a rezoning classification has asked him to weigh in on the Drainage system they are developing. Mr. Gaston said he informed them that the I-74 roadside ditch was not an adequate outlet for the project. They would still like to meet with him to discuss the project. The Board thanked him for the update.
