RE: HENDRICKS COUNTY SURVEYOR DAVID GASTON:

Hendricks County Attorney

Hendricks County Surveyor David Gaston stated that the Hendricks County Commissioners had voted to approve the Hendricks County Attorney's fee increase from \$275.00 per hour to \$300.00 per hour retroactive to January 1, 2022. Discussion followed. Member Dennis Dawes moved to raise the fee paid to Hendricks County Attorney by the Drainage Board from \$275.00 per hour to \$300.00 per hour retroactive to January 1, 2022. Member Stan Ryland seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.

ARP Funds

Mr. Gaston asked if there was any update on the ARP funds. Member Dennis Dawes stated that the committee had some questions about the Surveyor's Office request and would like for him to attend their next meeting on Monday, May 16th at 8:00am. Mr. Gaston stated we would be happy to attend and have Tiffany Dalton and Dirk Leonard attend also.

RE: IN THE MATTER OF WISHES TO BE HEARD:

Continental Estates – Jessica Smith

President Gentry recognized Mrs. Jessica Smith of Continental Estates. Mrs. Smith stated that she and other homeowners had been waiting a long time for their drainage problem to be fixed and wanted to know when the

County was going to start work. Mr. Gaston informed her that his office was waiting on funds from the ARP Grant and then they would begin the work if it was approved, and the funds were received. After Mr. Gentry asked the details of the drainage issues, Hendricks County Inspector Dirk Leonard stated that in the past a drainage pipe was installed from the east and daylighted on Mrs. Smith's property and the swale that it daylighted into was not large enough to handle the water during large storm events and turned the yards into a marsh. He stated the easement was only 7.5 feet wide and had utilities running through it therefore, there was not enough room to do any other drainage improvements. He stated that Banning Engineering had come up with a plan to install inlets and pipes from the backyard of every other house out to the street drain which would have to be enlarged to handle the volume. Discussion followed. It was the consensus of the Board to begin work as soon as ARP money became available and to keep Mrs. Smith informed.

Mary A. Gibbs Regulated Drain

Member Jack Maloney asked what progress had been made on the Mary A. Gibbs Regulated Drain project. Hendricks County Chief Deputy Surveyor Tiffany Dalton stated they were being held up by CSX Railroad who was reviewing the project and kept asking for more detailed information or suggesting alternatives to the design specifications and contractor. Deputy Dalton said she explained to CSX the contract for the design and contractor had already been signed and no changes would be made. Member Jack Maloney and President Gentry asked Hendricks County Attorney Greg Steuerwald to see if he could expedite the project.

Seeing nothing further before the Board, Vice President Palmer moved to adjourn the meeting. Member Stan Ryland seconded the motion. The motion was passed unanimously.
