After reviewing the quotes Hendricks County Inspector Blake Stephenson recommended Murrain Excavating as they had the lowest responsible quote of \$25,000.00. Discussion followed. Member Dennis Dawes moved to follow the recommendation. Member Jack Maloney seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously passed.

## **Pollard Todd Regulated Drain**

President Gentry was informed that the Surveyor's Office had received 3 sealed quotes for the Pollard Todd Regulated Drain project. President Gentry requested the quotes be opened and read aloud. The quotes were as follows:

After reviewing the quotes Hendricks County Inspector Blake Stephenson recommended Murrain Excavating as they had the lowest responsible quote of \$15,500.00. Discussion followed. Member Jack Maloney moved to follow the recommendation. Member Dennis Dawes seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously passed.

#### RE: IN THE MATTER OF WISHES TO BE HEARD:

#### **Continental Estates**

Hendricks County Inspector Dirk Leonard presented the Board with pictures showing standing water in the swale on Mrs. Jessica Smith's parcel in Continental Estates. Discussion followed. Hendricks County Chief Deputy Surveyor Tiffany Dalton said that some ARP Grant money that had just been awarded would be used to fix the drainage issue in Continental Estates. The Board thanked the Chief Deputy and asked that someone from the Surveyor's Office inform Mrs. Smith.

# RE: INTRODUCTION OF OTHER BUSINESS OR ADDITIONAL DISCUSSION BY BOARD MEMBERS:

#### **Town of Clayton**

Member Jack Maloney stated that Mr. David Coogan near the Town of Clayton may be contacting the Surveyor's Office concerning a Removal of Obstruction. He said that allegedly Mr. Coogan's neighbor has

stopped up the drainage to form a small pond for ducks. Chief Deputy Dalton said she had not received any call as of today but thanked Member Maloney for the information.

## **Timothy Quinn Regulated Drain**

Member Maloney asked for an update on the Quinn Regulated Drain project with INDOT. Chief Deputy Dalton said she had been in contact with INDOT and informed them that the project would need Drainage Board approval. She said she believed they were in the final planning phase of the project.

#### Mary A. Gibbs Regulated Drain

Member Maloney asked for an update on the Mary A. Gibbs Regulated Drain project with CSX Railroad. Chief Deputy Dalton and Inspector Blake Stephenson informed the Board that all the paperwork had been finalized and, weather permitting, the work would begin the week of July 4<sup>th</sup>.

#### **Danville Conservation Club Dam Regulated Drain**

Member Dennis Dawes said he had left a message for Mr. Gary Everling about accessing the Danville Conservation Club Dam from the Hendricks Regional Health property but had not heard back from him.

#### Avondale Heights Subdivsion.

Member Dennis Dawes stated he had received a call and letter from Mrs. Rebecca Regan of Avondale Heights Subdivsion about a drainage issue she was having. Chief Deputy Dalton informed the Board that Avondale Heights was not a regulated drain and therefore the Surveyor's Office would not be able to help fix any drainage within that subdivision. She recommended Mrs. Regan contact her HOA or if the problem was within the road right of way the Hendricks County Highway Department.
