




Immunizations Given Through Health Department 2012-2016






Environmental Permits Issued










Completed CDC Core Capabilities 2012-2016



Assuring healthy communities is the focus of public health. The Health Department is pursing voluntary accreditation through the national Public Health Accreditation Board. Accreditation aligns services with nationally recognized standards, enhances the capacity of public health to deliver services that community needs and expects, and promotes a strong, efficient system to improve community health.

- Received a grant for 50 naloxone rescue kits to facilitate drug death reduction activities outlined in the community health improvement plan
- Received \$7,995.00 in sponsorship funds for the Partnership to implement community health improvement activities

- Implemented a comprehensive performance evaluation and improvement system to include employee performance evaluations, competency-based evaluations, work environment needs assessment, and individual development plans
