TAX WARRANTS

The Sheriff of the county is tasked with assisting in the collection of monies owed to the Indiana Department of Revenue through a process of Tax Warrants. A Tax Warrant is not an arrest warrant. Instead, this is a chance to make voluntary restitution for taxes owed. Tax Warrants are issued by written letter, never by telephone. If you receive a written Tax Warrant, please *read the letter in its entirety* and follow these steps.

Tax Warrant Instructions:

- If you are disputing the <u>amount owed</u>, call the Department of Revenue at 317/232-2165. Do <u>not</u> call the Hendricks County Sheriff's Office, as this agency has nothing to do with setting the amount of taxes owed.
- 2. After you have read your letter and wish to set up a payment plan, you may call the Hendricks County Sheriff's office at 317/745-6269. You have up to 12 months from the date of issuance of the tax warrant to pay, so long as monthly payments are being made. We request a 20% down payment of the total amount owed. Once your payment information is received, the State will be notified of your intention to meet the tax obligation.
