### **<u>RE: HENDRICKS COUNTY SURVEYOR DAVID GASTON:</u>**

#### Windfield Regulated Drain Project

The Board was informed that while all contractors on the Surveyor's Office list had been notified of the project only 1 showed up for the walkthrough and only 1 sealed quote had been received for the Windfield Regulated Drain project. President Gentry requested for it to be opened. The quote was as follows:

Murrain Excavating \$ 31,650.00

After reviewing the quote Inspector Dirk Leonard recommended Murrain Excavating as they had the lowest responsible quote at \$31,650.00. Discussion followed. Member Dennis Dawes moved to follow the recommendation. Member Jack Maloney seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously passed.

#### **James Phillips Regulated Drain Project**

The Board was informed 3 sealed quotes had been received for the James Phillips Regulated Drain project. President Gentry requested they be opened. The quotes were as follows:

Murrain Excavating	\$ 94,750.00
Alexander Contractors	\$105,532.00

After reviewing the quotes Inspector Blake Stephenson recommended Beechwood Construction as they had the lowest responsible quote at \$88,800.00. Discussion followed. Member Jack Maloney moved to follow the recommendation. Member Dennis Dawes seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously passed.

#### John Lackey- Drain vacation request

Inspector Blake Stephenson informed the Board that Mr. Pat Wynne had requested that the upper end of the John Lackey Drain be vacated where it ran through his property. Mr. Gaston stated he had no issue with vacating that portion as Mr. Wynne was the only parcel owner that would be affected. Discussion followed. Member Jack Maloney moved to Vacate the portion of the John Lackey Regulated Drain from the railroad line to State Road 136 as it ran through Mr. Wynne's parcel. Member Dennis Dawes seconded the motion the motion was unanimously approved.

# William Brown Arm 1 Regulated Drain

Hendricks County Surveyor David Gaston stated he had been working with INDOT on the William Brown Arm 1 Regulated Drain that runs concurrently under US 136 near the old drive-in theatre. INDOT has requested the Board Vacate Arm 1 as it no longer functions and serves no purpose. Mr. Gaston stated that the drain has been marginal at best for some time and because it runs under the road for a lengthy distance it's not repairable. He recommended vacating the drain and continue working with INDOT in establishing a new drain within their right of way to support the drainage on the northside of the road. Discussion followed. Member Jack Maloney moved to follow the Surveyor's recommendation. Member Dennis Dawes seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously passed.

### Installation Technical Standard for the Wheel Machine

Mr. Gaston said, as requested by the Board, he had been working with Member Stan Ryland and Joe Miller of Banning Engineering to establish a policy and technical standard for the use of a wheel machine when installing county regulated drains. He informed the Board that a draft copy and diagram of the policy was in their binders. Mr. Miller stated that the tile manufacturer as well as several other counties require that the tile be back filled with stone and the old tile removed. Mr. Gaston stated that removing the old tile was a must as it was the only sure way to find all the lateral connections. He asked the Board to take the documents under advisement for discussion at a later date. The Board thanked the group for all of their work and agreed to review the material.
