Regarding: Well Abandonment Requirements

Dear Hendricks County Property Owner:

Prior to the demolition of any structure in Hendricks County which utilizes a groundwater well, you must provide the Hendricks County Health Officer with documentation of well abandonment or global positioning system (GPS) coordinates. Hendricks County Ground Water Well Ordinance No. 2016 – 37 Section V, states:

Groundwater wells must be properly abandoned in accordance with 312 IAC 13.

Any groundwater well connected to an existing structure that is scheduled for demolition must be either:

- a. Properly abandoned in accordance with 312 IAC 13 or other applicable regulations, with written verification submitted to the Local Health Officer prior to initiating demolition of the structure, or
- b. Located by global positioning system for later abandonment, with written notification and well location submitted to the Local Health Officer prior to initiating demolition of the structure.

These regulations along with Title 312 Indiana Administrative Code (IAC) 13 can be obtained from our department or online

(https://www.co.hendricks.in.us/topic/index.php?topicid=70&structureid=16).

We request that you send a copy of the well abandonment log or other required documentation to the Environmental Health address or fax number above prior to the demolition of any structure served by an existing groundwater well. In addition, septic tanks should be pumped, crushed and filled with inert material, or removed for future safety. Please forward a copy of the pump receipt to our office.
