

Ordinance No. 2015- 41

Ordinance Amending Fees Assessed by Hendricks County Problem Solving Court

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Hendricks County, Indiana ("Commissioners") is the executive and legislative body of Hendricks County;

WHEREAS, the Commissioners have intended to provide problem-solving court services to participants pursuant to IC 33-23-16;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 2011-21 the Commissioners established the Hendricks County Problem Solving Court Fund to fund the administration of the Problem-Solving Court; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ORDAINED by the Commissioners that the fees assessed by the Problem Solving Court are amended as follows:

Section 2. Fees

- a. The Problem Solving Court will charge fees authorized by this Ordinance and may develop and observe written policy and procedure on the assessment and collection of fees.
- b. Participants admitted to Problem Solving Court shall be assessed a problem solving court administration fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for initial problem solving court services.
- c. Participants admitted to Problem Solving Court shall be assessed a monthly user fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) beginning with the second month of participation and for each month thereafter for the duration of their participation in the program.
- d. Participants admitted to Problem Solving Court shall be responsible for all chemical testing fees. Participants shall be assessed eight dollars (\$8.00) per urine drug screen. Participants shall also be responsible for the cost of any confirmatory test
