#### MAJOR PLAT (PRELIMINARY):

#### **S-09-18 (Sonora)** – County

274 lots on 129.05 acres in Brown Township, S5-T16N-R2E, located on the Northwest corner of Raceway Road and County Road 650 North. (Banning Engineering) – *Sonora Regulated Drain* (771) - \$100.00/Lot (New Regulated Drain).

Hendricks County Surveyor David Gaston recommended the Hendricks County Drainage Board grant Preliminary Approval of S-09-18 (Sonora) subject to the conditions of the Hendricks County Surveyor's letter, all the requirements and conditions of the Hendricks County Stormwater Management Handbook, and a \$100.00 per lot assessment payable to the Sonora Regulated Drain (771). Member Bob Gentry moved to follow the Surveyor's recommendation. Members Jack Maloney and Stan Ryland seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously passed.

Hendricks County Surveyor David Gaston recommended the Hendricks County Drainage Board Continue the Ronald Reagan Parkway (Segment 1A & 1B) project. Member Bob Gentry moved to follow the Surveyor's recommendation. Member Jack Maloney seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously passed.

#### **MAJOR PLAT (FINAL):**

#### S-02-05 (Whitmore Place Section 3) – Plainfield

39 lots on 22.64 acres in Washington Township, S23-T15N-R1E, located approximately 1,800 feet north and 1,320 feet east of the intersection of Avon Avenue and County Road 300 South in the Town of Plainfield. (Banning Engineering) – *Hidden Valley Regulated Drain (647) - \$50.00/Lot (Outlet Only)*.

Hendricks County Surveyor David Gaston recommended the Hendricks County Drainage Board grant Final Approval of S-02-05 (Whitmore Place Section 3) subject to the conditions of the Hendricks County Surveyor's letter, all the requirements and conditions of the Hendricks County Stormwater Management Handbook, and a \$50.00 per lot assessment payable to the Hidden

Valley Regulated Drain (647). Member Bob Gentry moved to follow the Surveyor's recommendation. Member Jack Maloney seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously passed.

## S-05-17 (Steel Dynamics Inc, Laydown Yard) – Pittsboro

1 lot on 41.76 acres in Middle Township, S36-17N-R1W, located on the south side of Interstate 74 approximately 1,294 feet west of Jeff Gordon Boulevard in the Town of Pittsboro. (Banning Engineering) – Roseboom Regulated Drain (415) (John G. McCord 423) \$100.00/Acre.

Hendricks County Surveyor David Gaston recommended the Hendricks County Drainage Board grant Final Approval of S-05-17 (Steel Dynamics Inc, Laydown Yard) subject to the conditions of the Hendricks County Surveyor's letter, all the requirements and conditions of the Hendricks County Stormwater Management Handbook, and a \$100.00 per acre assessment payable to the Roseboom Regulated Drain (415). Member Bob Gentry moved to follow the Surveyor's recommendation. Members Jack Maloney and Stan Ryland seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously passed.

### S-02-18 (Greystone Section 1) – Brownsburg

65 lots on 41.64 acres in Brown Township, S3&4-T16N-R1E, located on the west side of County Road 625 East, approximately 750 feet north of West Northfield Drive in the Town of Brownsburg. (HWC Engineering) – *Holloway Regulated Drain (476) – \$100.00/Lot (Outlet Only)*.

Hendricks County Surveyor David Gaston recommended the Hendricks County Drainage Board grant Final Approval of S-02-18 (Greystone Section 1) subject to the conditions of the Hendricks County Surveyor's letter, all the requirements and conditions of the Hendricks County Stormwater Management Handbook, and a \$100.00 per lot assessment payable to the Holloway Regulated Drain (476). Discussion followed. President Whetstone requested a motion on the Drainage Board's participation in the reconstruction tile portion of the Holloway Regulated Drain which is the outlet for the Greystone Subdivision. He then moved to reconstruct said tile portion of the Holloway Regulated Drain with the Surveyor's Office overseeing all the work and billing Pulte Homes for fifty percent of the total cost. Member Bob Gentry seconded the motion. Discussion followed. Vice President Palmer was concerned that this would set a precedent for all other builders to request the same type of participation from the county. Discussion followed. Member Bob Gentry called for the Question. The motion was passed on a 3-2 vote with Vice President Palmer and Member Stan Ryland voting against. President Whetstone then called for a motion on S-02-18 Greystone Section 1. Member Bob Gentry moved to follow the Surveyor's recommendation. Member Jack Maloney seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously passed.

### MINOR PLAT (PRELIMINARY & FINAL):

#### **MIP 1094/18 (Larkin)** – County

2 lots on 11.646 acres in Liberty Township, S26-T15N-R1W, located on the northwest corner of Cartersburg Road and County Road 200 East. (Kruse Consulting) – No Regulated Drain

Hendricks County Surveyor David Gaston recommended the Hendricks County Drainage Board Continue MIP 1094/18 project. Discussion followed. President Whetstone recognized Dale

Kruse, engineer for the project. Mr. Kruse made a plea for the Board to hear the project over Mr. Gaston's recommendation to continue. Discussion followed. Member Jack Maloney moved to hear the project. Member Bob Gentry seconded the motion. The motion was passed on a 3-2 vote with President Whetstone and Vice President Palmer voting against the motion. Mr. Kruse presented the general conditions and drainage layout for the project. President Whetstone then asked the Surveyor for his recommendation. Mr. Gaston stated he recommended the homeowner better define the blanket easement on his property. But as for the project, he would go along with whatever the Board decided. Member Bob Gentry moved to approve the project as presented. Member Stan Ryland seconded the motion. The motion was passed on a 4-1 vote with Vice President Palmer voting against the motion.

### MIP 1095/18 (Patterson) - County

2 lots on 8.44 acres in Washington Township, S35-T16N-R1E, located on the west side of County Road 800 East, approximately 380 feet north of Cedar Drive. (Kruse Consulting) – **J.F.** Lingerman Regulated Drain (499) - \$100.00/Lot

Hendricks County Surveyor David Gaston recommended the Hendricks County Drainage Board grant Preliminary and Final Approval of MIP 1095/18 (Patterson) subject to the conditions of the Hendricks County Surveyor's letter, all the requirements and conditions of the Hendricks County Stormwater Management Handbook, and a \$100.00 per lot assessment payable to the J.F. Lingerman Regulated Drain (499). Member Bob Gentry moved to follow the Surveyor's recommendation. President Whetstone seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously passed.
