Town of Plainfield Regulated Drain Transfer

William Batz Arm 2 – Final Plan and Cost Analysis – Joe Miller

Mr. Gaston stated Joe Miller of Banning Engineering was ready to present the William Batz Arm 2 Regulated Drain project. Mr. Miller gave a Power-Point presentation showing the overall condition of the drain and how the project would progress. Mr. Miller stated that he estimated the Drainage Board portion of the project would be \$79,930.00 and the Highway Department portion would be \$89,610.00. Discussion followed. Member Bob Gentry moved to approve the Drainage Board's portion of the project. Member Jack Maloney seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously passed. President Whetstone reminded Mr. Miller that he would need to bring the Highway's portion before the Commissioners for consideration.
