## **DETERMINATION OF A QUORUM AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

4th QUARTER 2018 REIMBURSEMENT & 1st QUARTER 2019 ESTIMATED REIMBURSEMENT

Jeremy Gooch reported the County received a reimbursement of \$146,537.03 for the fourth quarter of 2018 and stated the first quarter claim for reimbursement has already been submitted and is estimated to be \$150,000. The total 40% reimbursement amount for 2018 was \$593,499.48.

Mr. Gooch mentioned to the Board that the staff would be working on the 2019 July – December contracts. There was additional discussion regarding the Board members' appointments and news from the State regarding indigent defense matters.
