



**FINDING OF FACT  
HENDRICKS COUNTY DRAINAGE BOARD  
HENDRICKS COUNTY, INDIANA**

WHEREAS, Hendricks County Drainage Board shall in all cases heard by it, make written findings of fact which support their determinations in accordance with Indiana Code 36-9-27-34(D) and Indiana Code 36-9-27-37; and

WHEREAS, the Hendricks County Drainage Board has held a public hearing and has given consideration for the Re-Assessment of the Hidden Valley, Gilbert Woods, and Springtown Heights Regulated Drains; and

WHEREAS, the Hendricks County Drainage Board approved the Re-Assessment of the Hidden Valley, Gilbert Woods, and Springtown Heights Regulated Drain as presented by the Hendricks County Surveyor at the said hearing on October 9<sup>th</sup>, 2019;

WHEREAS, the Hendricks County Drainage Board has given consideration to the above referenced Re-Assessment hearing with the recommendations, stipulations or any necessary conditions, listed below, requested by the public, the Hendricks County Surveyor and the Hendricks County Drainage Board Members;

SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING:

1. CONDITIONS & RECOMMENDATIONS IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S LETTER DATED FEBRUARY 2019 AND UPDATED SEPTEMBER 9<sup>th</sup>, 2019. RECOMMENDING RAISING THE ANNUAL ASSESSMENT TO COUNTY MINIMUM OF \$100.00 PER PARCEL FOR SUBDIVISIONS.
2. CONDITIONS & RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE HENDRICKS COUNTY DRAINAGE BOARD.
