

RAILROAD SAFETY TIPS

- Remember that trains do not run on set schedules and can be on the track at any time.
- Slow down when approaching a railroad crossing and look both ways twice.
- When approaching a crossing, roll down your windows, turn off the radio and listen for whistles or bells.
- Always yield to flashing lights, whistles, closing gates, or stop signs.
- Don't be fooled by the optical illusion presented by the train. It is always moving faster and is much closer than you think.
- Always yield the right of way to the train. The train cannot yield to you.
