RESOLUTION ASSIGNING A TAX SALE CERTIFICATE  
TO THE TOWN OF PLAINFIELD

WHEREAS, Hendricks County, Indiana, by and through its Board of Commissioners, is the holder of three tax sale certificates on the properties described in Exhibit A attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to I.C. 6-1.1-24-9(d), the Hendricks County Board of Commissioners may assign tax sale certificates held in the name of the county executive to any political subdivision; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Plainfield, Indiana has expressed a desire to obtain tax sale certificates on the properties described in Exhibit A and has filed with the Hendricks County Board of Commissioners an Application for Assignment of Tax Sale Certificate; and



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HENDRICKS COUNTY, INDIANA BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS that:


1. That Hendricks County, Indiana by and through its Board of Commissioners hereby approves the assignment of those tax sale certificates held by the county to the Town of Plainfield, Indiana for the properties described in Exhibit A attached hereto.
2. That all taxes, penalties and assessments against the properties described herein shall be waived for the tax year 2016 payable 2017 and prior as to the Town of Plainfield, Indiana so that there shall be no cost to the Town.
3. That the period of redemption of the property described herein shall be for one hundred twenty (120) days from the date the certificate is assigned pursuant to Indiana Code.

Dear Jay and Todd,

On November 18, 2016, The Hendricks County Home Detention Officers experienced technical difficulties with receiving alerts for clients who were on Home Detention per the Court. Specifically, for a period of approximately five hours, alerts were not being sent via email or text message to Home Detention Officers. The Hendricks County Home Detention Coordinator contacted Hendricks County IT personnel when the issue was discovered, as well as the electronic monitoring company used; BI inc. BI inc. Staff and Hendricks County IT personnel worked together to resolve the issue and alerts were once again received by the evening of November 18, 2016.

In dealing with this issue, the question did arise as to the responsibility of Hendricks County IT personnel to be responsive outside of standard work hours; Monday-Friday from 8am to 4:30pm. The Probation Department is seeking clarification on this issue should future issues arise.
