Regulated Drain Assessments – Recommendations for suspension of assessments for the 2025 tax year.

President Gentry recognized Joe Miller from Banning Engineering. Mr. Miller said his team investigated the berm between the Ross Regulated Drain and the Conn family's barrow pit pond. He showed several pictures that indicated that the banks had not been reduced as much as previously thought. In his opinion, the banks did need some class 1 rip rap placed on both sides. Discussion followed. Member Dennis Dawes moved to follow Mr. Miller's suggestion and get a quote from the contractor that did that phase of the ditch work for placing rip rap where needed. President Gentry seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved. President Gentry also stated that the landowners might want to do some aesthetic work, but that would be at their own expense and with the approval of the Surveyor's Office.
