## RESOLUTION NO. 2025-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF HENDRICKS COUNTY, INDIANA REGARDING ESTABLISHING AN ADDITIONAL LOCATION FOR THE OFFICE OF THE HENDRICKS COUNTY CIRCUIT COURT CLERK TO CONDUCT EARLY VOTING AT AVON UNITED METHODIST CHURCH

Whereas, Hendricks County, Indiana (County) pursuant to a request by the election division of the Hendricks County Circuit Court Clerk's Office (Voter Registration) finds that: Under I.C. 3-11-10-26(a), there must always be early voting at the location of circuit court clerk office:

- (a) This subsection applies to all counties, except for a county to which I.C. 3-6-5.2 or I.C. 3-6-5.6 applies. As an alternative to voting by mail, a voter is entitled to cast an absentee ballot in person before an absentee board voter at any of the following:
- (1) One (1) Location of the office of the circuit court clerk designated by the circuit court clerk.
- (2) A satellite office established under section 26.3 of this chapter.

  Whereas the County desires to accommodate the voting public affected by the November 4, 2025, Special Election to find a more suitable location for early voting in person.

  Whereas, the Avon United Methodist Church is located within Washington Township, where the need for absentee early voting in person is more appropriate for voters and,

  Whereas, the Circuit Court Clerk's Office (Voter Registration) has reserved the Avon United Methodist Church for the purpose of conducting early voting under I.C.3-11-10-26(a);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED

That the Hendricks County Board of Commissioners, Hendricks County, Indiana, hereby establishes that the Avon United Methodist Church shall serve as an additional location for the Hendricks County Circuit Court Clerk may designate the location provide early voting for the November 4, 2025, special election for at least 6 days, including a Saturday before election day and subject to any other applicable statutory duties of the Circuit Court

Clerk's Office (Voter Registration) established by statute or in the county vote center plan established under I.C. 3-11-18-18.1.
